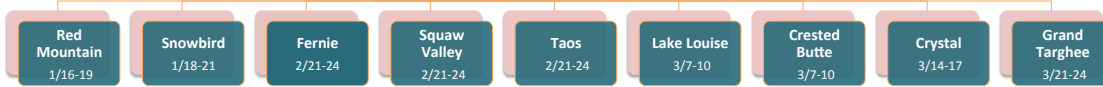

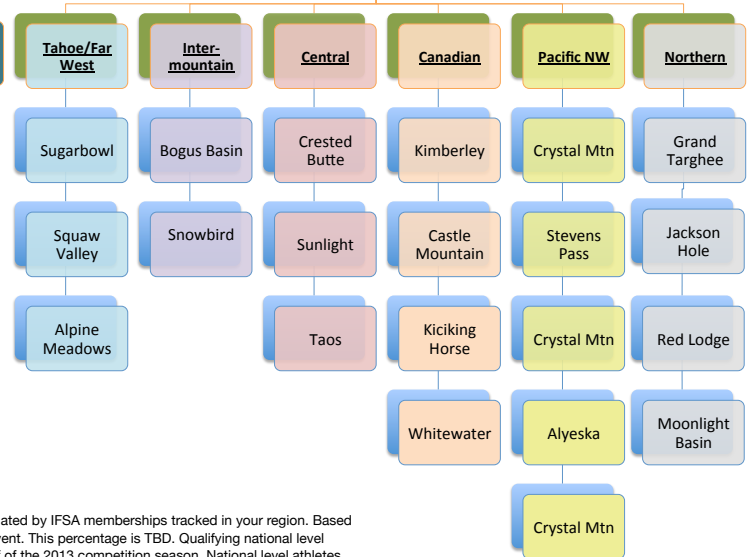
### National Series

#### Qualifying for Revelstoke NA Championships

Quotas to be based off of overall regional participation and national events. Regional event quotas will be calculated by IFSA memberships tracked in your region. Based off of each regions overall regional ranking, a percentage will be invited to the North American Championship event. This percentage is TBD. Qualifying national level athletes will be based of the 2013 National Series taking into account your three best national finishes based off of the 2013 competition season. National level athletes may also qualify in based off of regional points if they don't qualify through their national points. The North American Championship event will count as a National Series event and can count as the fourth finish towards the overall 2013 IFSA Junior Event Series. There will be no team quotas for the North American Championship event. The North American Championship event will be 4-5 days long and will be the last event of the season
